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Agency Hours: We are open Monday – Friday 8:30 am – 6:30 pm except on Thursdays when we are closed from 1 pm – 5 pm. We are open on weekends for meals only.

Meals: Lunch and dinner is served every day (7 days a week) from 11:30 am – 12:30 pm and 5:30 pm – 6:30 pm.

Fresh Choice Food Pantry: People in need of food assistance can select fresh and shelf-stable food from our pantry monthly. The pantry is open on Mondays (1 pm – 4 pm), Wednesdays (1 pm - 3 pm), and Fridays (1 pm – 3 pm). To sign up for a time to visit the pantry, talk with someone at the outreach desk between 11 am - 1 pm.

People unable to come when the pantry is open can request a non-perishable food box during outreach hours (Monday – Friday from 11 am - 1 pm and 5:00 pm - 6:30 pm) or by appointment.

Mailing Address and On-Site Message Service (for people experiencing homelessness): Mail pick-up times are Monday – Friday from 11 am – 1 pm and 5 pm - 6:30 pm or by appointment. Messages are posted on the board in the dining room.

Homeless Identification Program: Assists people with obtaining birth certificates and Nebraska State IDs. Due to limited funds, a letter on agency letterhead from a case worker stating that the person in need is working on life goals is required. Must be experiencing homelessness and be without income to qualify. Talk with staff during outreach hours (Monday – Friday from 11 am - 1 pm and 5:00 pm - 6:30 pm) or call to schedule an appointment.

Showers and Laundry Services (for people experiencing homelessness): Available Monday – Friday at no cost. Call for eligibility guidelines. Must meet with a staff person during outreach hours (Monday – Friday from 11 am - 1 pm and 5:00 pm - 6:30 pm) or by appointment before using the service for the first time.

Substance Use Services: Substance use counseling and drug/alcohol evaluations are available for people experiencing homelessness who are 19 years old or older. Contact Clarence Grendahl at 402-817-0614 for more information. An 8 and 15-hour Alcohol Education class occurs on the 4th weekend of each month and is open to the community for a fee. Register for classes at mtko.org.

Weekly AA Meeting: The meeting is held every Tuesday at 5:05 pm. You are welcome to stay for dinner which is served until 6:30pm.

CEDARS Street Outreach Services (S.O.S.): Provides street-based services to homeless and at-risk youth under age 21. SOS staff provide support to youth as they work to leave the streets for safe shelter. SOS offers crisis intervention, access to CEDARS shelter, food, transportation, and personal hygiene items. SOS staff are at Matt Talbot on Wednesdays from 5 pm - 6 pm. For more information call 402-560-9356 or 402-560-9354.

Foot Clinic: Nursing and physician assistant students from Union College provide adult foot care, including soaking feet and trimming toenails. Individuals receive free socks and are eligible for free shoes once a year. Clinics are held in the fall and spring. Talk with staff during outreach hours (Monday – Friday from 11 am - 1 pm and 5:00 pm - 6:30 pm) for more information.

Lincoln Lancaster County Health Department: Provides flu and other immunizations during the winter months.

SNAP/Food Bank: Here on Mondays and Wednesdays from 10:30 am – 12:30 pm and on Fridays from 1:30 pm – 3:30 pm to provide assistance with getting and keeping SNAP. Please note they are not able to help obtain Medicaid.

Sober Housing and Case Management: Available to those struggling with substance use and homelessness. Contact Clarence Grendahl at 402-817-0614 to learn more.

Gasoline Vouchers: Available on the first business day of the month. Must have proof of insurance, a valid driver's license, and current automobile registration. Individuals can receive one voucher every 6 months.

Haircut Vouchers: Available once every 30 days. Vouchers can be redeemed at the College of Hair Design downtown on Wednesdays. Speak with outreach staff Monday - Friday from 11 am – 1 pm or 5 - 6:30 pm for more information or to obtain a voucher.
