#### Questions Heard Around the MTKO Kitchen about Food Safety

If you have questions about food safety, please email Sydne at <u>Sydne.Wirrick-Knox@MTKO.org</u>. If I don't know the answer, I will do some research and send my reply through the monthly newsletter.

Question: Sell-by, Best-by and Use by. What do these dates really mean?

Answer: Always exercise caution if you have any concerns about a product's integrity or food safety: Remember: WHEN IN DOUBT, THROW IT OUT!

"Sell-by" - tells a store how long to display the product for sale. A product should be sold before the "sell-by" date expires.

"Best if Used By (or before)"- recommended for best flavor or quality. It is not a purchase or safety date. That means the food can still be used safely.

"Use By" - the last date recommended for use of the product while at peak quality. The manufacturer of the product has determined the date.

#### **Important Reminders for MTKO Hunger Relief Teams**

Please do not serve 2<sup>nd</sup> servings until 12:00 PM for lunch and 6:00 PM for evening meal. If we <u>all</u> follow the same procedures, it is less confusing for our guests.

Remember all condiments (salt, pepper, ketchup, mustard, mayo, nondairy creamer and sugar) must be served by hunger relief volunteers. That is the reason that MTKO is providing these individual prepackaged servings. It keeps us all safer if many hands don't touch the larger condiment bottles.

All drinks (bottled water, cartons of milk and coffee) must be served by volunteers. Please only one milk and one water per meal. If you are curious about how many meals to prepare, you can go to our website to see the daily trends: MTKO.org; Relieving Hunger; Hunger Relief Volunteers; Daily Meal Totals. The meal numbers are updated twice each week on our website (usually on Mondays and Fridays).

#### Masks are required for all Staff, Volunteers, & Guests until Further Notice


